The different Commissions focus their meetings around a unique theme each year. This ensures focused attention between all the participants. - UNPFII United Nations Permanent Forum on Indigenous Issues 2021 Theme: Peace, justice and strong institutions, the role of Indigenous people in implementing Sustainable Development Goal 16.
- Commission on Social Development 2021 theme: Socially just transition towards sustainable development: The role of digital technologies on social development and well-being of all.
- Commission on Population and Development 2021 theme: Population, food security, nutrition and sustainable development.
- Open-Ended Working Group on Ageing 2021 Theme: For the purpose of strengthening the protection of the human rights of older persons: Rights to work and access the labour market, access to justice, education, training, lifelong learning and capacity building, social protection, and social security.
