- Sustainable technology at various stages of economic development
- Food security: provision of the necessary quantity and quality of food for all
- Provision of sustainable energy for all
- Education for sustainability

We are all concerned about sustainability, for years this has become a global responsibility and we must work on solutions. So many aspects are affected and this can be irreversible for the future generation and our planet if we do not work intensively on sustainability in the next years.
